AI, IT'S ALL THE RAGE TODAY

Our web mechanic, Rich Courmettes, enjoys doing AI videos for our club events. We hope you enjoy his creativity and humor. He finds an appropriate still hi-res image, adds background and text, writes a cute script, chooses a matching voice (or clones a known one) and sends it all through "D-iD.com" an AI voice and narration generator. In 45 seconds he gets a short video we can share with you for an upcoming event. "Carlos", "Knucklehead", "Maggie Beginner" and "Trixie" are just some of the funny videos he created. There are hundreds of videos out there now that are completely AI generated. The background, signage, main character, multiple characters, camera movement, narration, music, voice and even song lyrics, if any, are all generated by a powerful computer. Yes, a computer can now write a new song and music and sing it too! The "author" just writes a 3-10 sentence prompt" (description of the scene). Then, the very high powered computer (using Nvidia processor chips) goes to work for a few minutes (or hours) and comes up with a few seconds of video. Words like "cinematic" "vintage" and "realistic" gives it that certain feel the computer understands.

In the course of Rich's research he has come across a few that are "RETRO" styling. It's interesting that the computer generates a 1950s or 60s style car into the future. Restyling a 1952 Buick or a 1960 Chevy makes these real "objects of beauty". Wouldn't you love to own


CAR SHOW
